Brief description of workshops / lectures/programs offered:

- Kumihimo -using a traditional marudai (braiding stand) - Beginner level.

I bring all the equipment for participants. Only need to have scissors and some masking tape. Each student will use a marudai (braiding stand) and Tama (weighted bobbins). I even bring the warps, ready to mount, to save time. We will cover history, end uses, finishing with an emphasis on jewelery, how to warp/dress the marudai etc. For a one day workshop (suggest 10 to 4) we would make 4 braids, each one a bit harder than the last and adding more tama bobbins. Square braid, Flat braid with chevrons, Spiral with a core and a more decorative Flat braid with hearts. The end product would be suitable for necklace, bracelet or small strap for a bag. Bonus offer: If any of the participants like Kumihimo, the equipment that I bring for each participant, may be purchased at the end of the session.
