Brief description of workshops / lectures/programs offered:

- Sprang, beginner level, no weaving experience required. Work on a ready-prepared frame to form a bag or cap. Emphasis is placed on identifying mistakes, how to fix, how to avoid these in the first place. Instructor provides the frames for \$30 per frame.
- Intermediate sprang, assumes knowledge of the basic stitch. We explore surface design, lace patterns, patterns in 'S' and 'Z', flat warp as well as circular warp.
- Fingerweaving, beginner level, assumes no knowledge of weaving, teaches the basic 'stitch' and an efficient manner to hold and manipulate the threads. Emphasis is placed on identifying mistakes, how to fix, how to avoid these in the first place. Participants produce a narrow band of the diagonal stripe. Information is given on more complex patterns.
- Advanced fingerweaving assumes knowledge of the basic stitch and presents complex patterns such as the diamond pattern, the 'W' pattern, the flame pattern and the arrow-and-lightning (Assumption) pattern,
