**Brief description of workshops / lectures/programs offered:**

I can teach the following workshops:

- spinning novelty yarns
- spinning yarn for a project/specific end use
- spinning woolen/worsted yarns
- how to spin a hand painted roving 12+ ways
- color theory in spinning
- how to copy a commercial yarn
- yarn properties & analysis
- beginning spinning (with a wheel)
- beginning spinning (with a spindle)
- intermediate spinning
- spinning for socks
- learning various drafting techniques
- how to get out of one's spinning rut
- fiber preparation: combing/carding
- dyeing using food coloring/kool aid
- student choice\* where each participant asks the teacher one question 2 weeks prior to the workshop and the workshop will serve to answer each question asked. This works best if the workshop is kept to a maximum of 10 students

**Other requirements (dietary, accommodations, locations where you will teach, etc.)**

- Accommodations would be required if the location of the workshop is more than 2 hours away and/or if the participants would like a two or more day workshop.
