

GUILD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PART 2

Expand on the following:

1. Intent of study or project (including the objectives that the guild hopes to achieve).
2. Title and short description of area of study.
3. Date of study, including the completion date of the study (12 month maximum period or, ideally, one guild year - i.e. September to June).
4. Anticipated costs involved. A brief budget is preferred (be as specific as possible).
5. Present a résumé of the guild's background, current activities and future goals in your fibre endeavours.
6. Provide a description about each of the five samples you have submitted (techniques, fibre content, etc.).
7. Include a short description of the way in which the guild plans to fulfill the obligations to report to the Ontario Handweavers & Spinners.

DO NOT PROVIDE ANY GUILD IDENTIFYING INFORMATION in your responses. A number will be assigned by the Awards Chair so that applicants may be evaluated anonymously.
